Course Description:

Collaborative Strategic Reading (CSR) combines essential reading comprehension strategies to improve students' understanding of text with paired learning groups. This is a supplemental reading strategy for 7th graders where students get differentiated instruction and are motivated to become better readers. CSR builds vocabulary and comprehension skills through a set of activities that will be completed daily. In CSR, students work in groups to help each other improve their reading skills. The teacher monitors the groups and provides assistance to help students reach targeted goals throughout the school year.

Student Learning Outcomes:

Students will read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension. Context will be used to confirm or self-correct word recognition and understanding. Students will draw evidence from narrative or expository texts to support analysis and reflection. They will engage effectively in a range of collaborative discussions (one-on-one, in groups, and teacher-led) with diverse partners on grade 7 topics, texts, and issues, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly.
